

Privacy Policy

By using our website, you agree to the collection and use of information by Birmingham Glass Solutions Ltd (hereinafter "Birmingham.mu") in accordance with this policy.

This document aims to help you understand how the Birmingham.mu collects, stores, uses and discloses your personal information (hereafter "Data") for providing services to you and the rights you have associated with such Data. It also covers the treatment of personally identifiable information collected when you are on this site, or when you use or avail Birmingham.mu's products and services.

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This website is owned by Birmingham Glass Solutions Ltd (hereinafter "Birmingham.mu").
- 1.2. In this Privacy Policy, "we", "us" and "our" refer to Birmingham Glass Solutions Ltd.
- 1.3. Birmingham.mu is committed to safeguarding the privacy of its website visitors including users, prospects, clients, service providers/ suppliers.
- 1.4. As required by the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (hereafter the "GDPR") and the Data Protection Act 2017 (hereafter the "DPA"), please take notice of the way we intend to use your personal data.
- 1.5. This Privacy Policy sets out the types of personal data we collect, how we collect and process that data, who we may share this information with and the rights you have in this respect.

2. About Us

- 2.1. Birmingham.mu is specialised in custom-designed, frameless, safety glass products such as frameless showers, balustrades, kitchen splashbacks and provides expert solutions to buildings to reduce window glare, UV and heat issues, for both residential and commercial use.
- 2.2. We are registered in Mauritius with the **Corporate and Business Registration Department** under registration number **C14125176** and with the **Construction Industry Development Board** under registration number **CT/BW/L/H-03302**, and our registered office is at 20201, Royal Road, Calebasses.

3. Personal Data Collection

- 3.1. For the purpose of providing you with efficient service, we may collect your personal data that is absolutely required. Personal data is any data from which you can be identified, and which relates to you.
- 3.2. The type of data collected by us depends on the purpose for which it is collected and used. We will only collect data that we need for that purpose.
- 3.3. Your personal data is being collected in the following ways:
 - 3.3.1. When you provide your Personal Data to us directly like for instance when you purchase our products, use any of our services, provide or offer to provide services to us and you exchange communications with us.
 - 3.3.2. When we obtain your Personal Data indirectly like for instance, your information which is shared with us by third parties. In such a case, the third party should confirm that you have consented to the disclosure of your personal data to us.

- 3.3.3. When your Personal Data is publicly available like for instance, based on your privacy settings for social media services, we may access information from those accounts or services; during your interactions with us via platforms such as Facebook.
- 3.3.4. While browsing and / or interacting on our website
- 3.4. The personal data that we collect and process may include:
 - 3.4.1. Personal contact details - Name, surname, physical address, email address, office phone, mobile phone, fax number.
 - 3.4.2. National identification details (issued by Government) such as National ID.
 - 3.4.3. Financial information - Bank details.
 - 3.4.4. IT data - IP addresses, type and version of browser, access time and duration, page views, user activity, website usage in log files.

4. Usage and disclosure of data collected

Birmingham.mu will make use of your personal data ONLY for the purposes for which it has been collected or agreed with you. Your personal data shall not be used for any automated individual decision-making process which could have a significant impact on you. We may use your Personal Data for the following purposes:

- 4.1. for the purpose of internal administration and marketing purposes;
- 4.2. managing our customer/prospect relations while processing your orders or responding to your requests;
- 4.3. regularly sending you news and information about Birmingham.mu, our brands, products or our initiatives that might arouse your interest;
- 4.4. to fulfill your requests for our products, partners and services or on special offers;
- 4.5. identifying you under legal circumstances or for verifying the accuracy of your Personal Data;
- 4.6. in aggregate form for demographic characterizations and internal marketing surveys;
- 4.7. for facilitation of performance or performance of a contract we have with you;
- 4.8. for generating data analytics to improve our web user experience, services and quality of communication with you;
- 4.9. for any other specific purpose indicated at the time of collecting the information.

Notwithstanding what is contained herein, Birmingham.mu reserves its right to send your Personal Data to other companies or people when:

- we have your consent to share the information;
- we need to share your information to provide the product or service you have requested;
- we need to send the information to companies who work on behalf of Birmingham.mu to provide a product or service to you;
- we respond to court orders or legal process;
- we need to protect and defend the rights or property of Birmingham.mu or enforce any terms and conditions for use and transactions on this website;
- we find that your actions on our web sites violate any of our web usage guidelines.

5. **Data Security**

Birmingham.mu attaches significant importance to the security of your personal data and has taken necessary steps to minimise risks related loss, spoilage or misuse of your personal data.

9. **Information about Cookies and Tracking**

This section features information about your rights and choices regarding cookies. Cookies are small text files which are transferred from our websites, applications or services and stored on your device. We use cookies to provide you with a personalised service, while helping us improve your user-experience when visiting our website.

While visiting Birmingham.mu and following your choice to allow or not cookies, cookies are likely to be installed on your device and information related to the browsing by your device is likely to be stored by those cookies. Cookies may be implemented by us or by some of our authorised partners.
